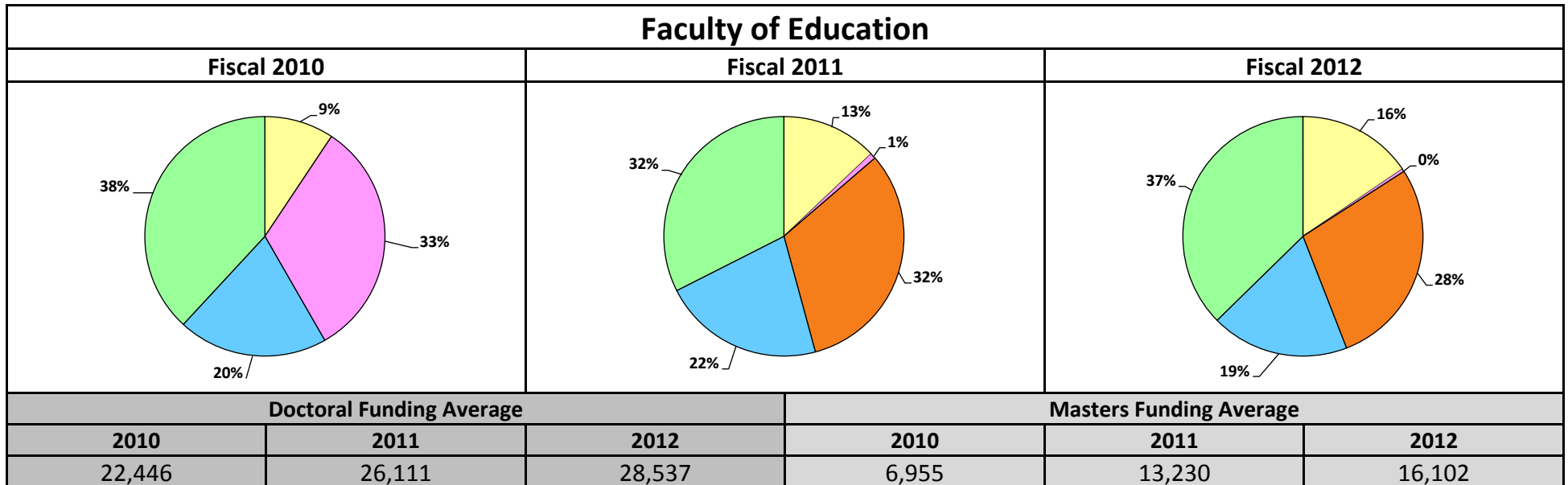

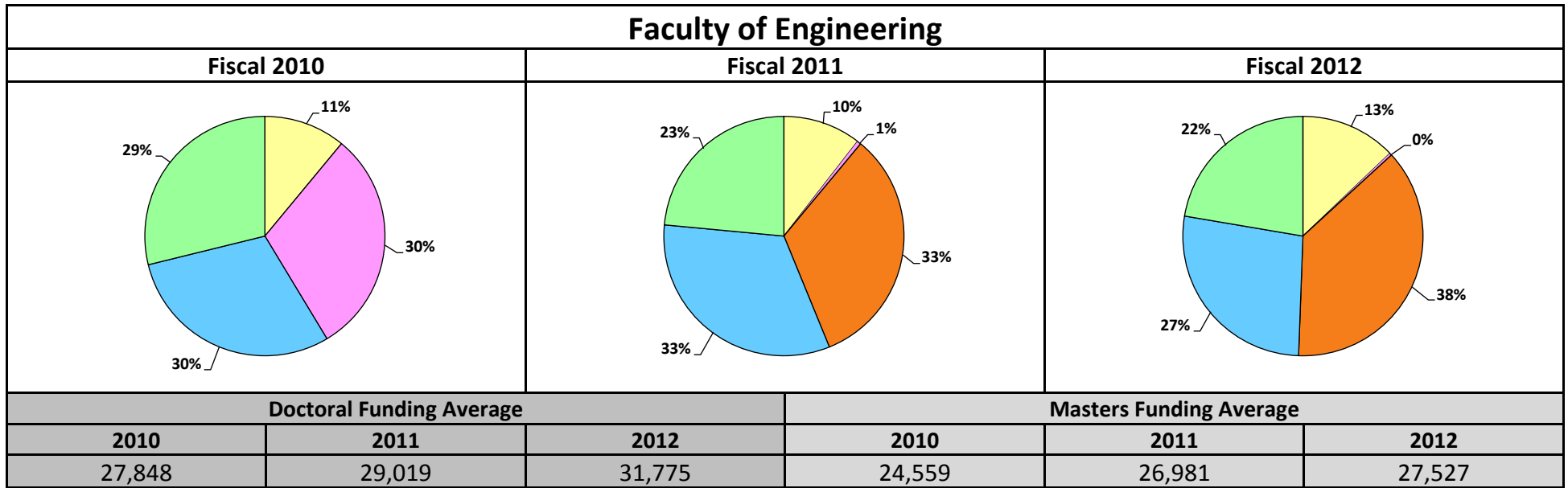

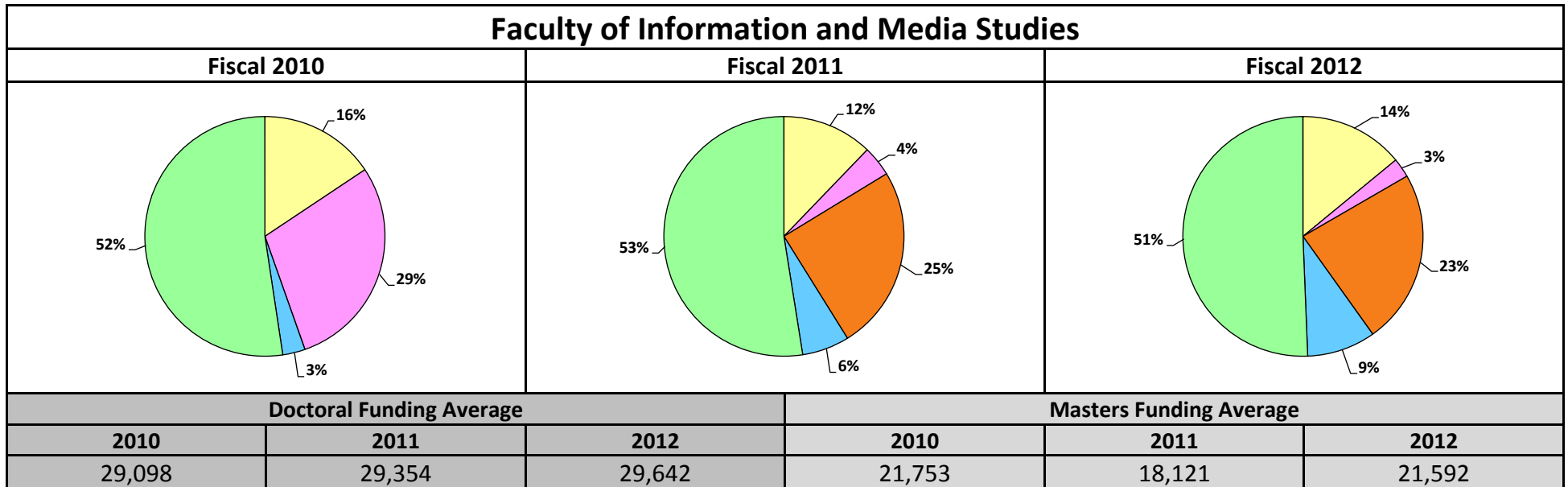

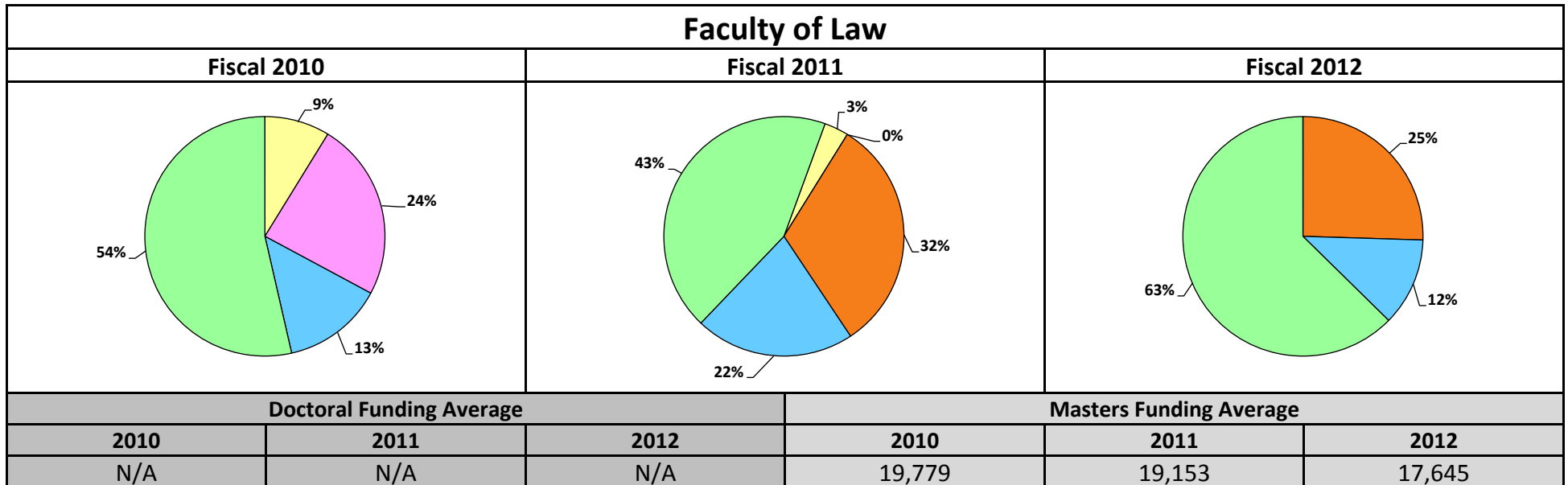

Graduate Student Funding Summary by Source

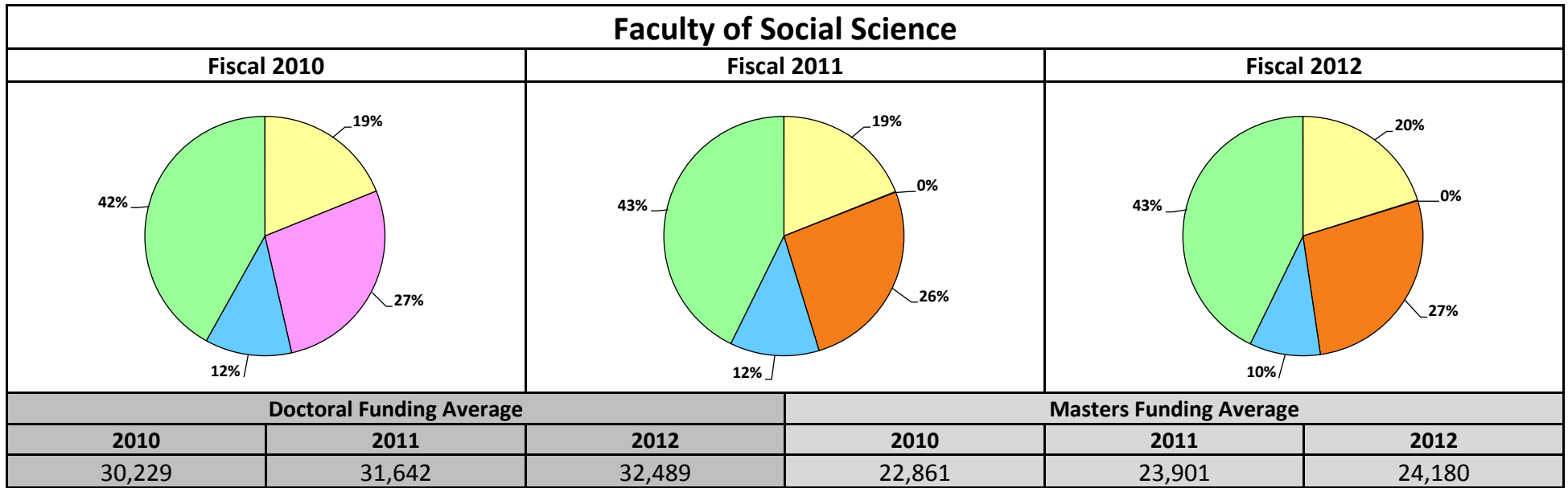

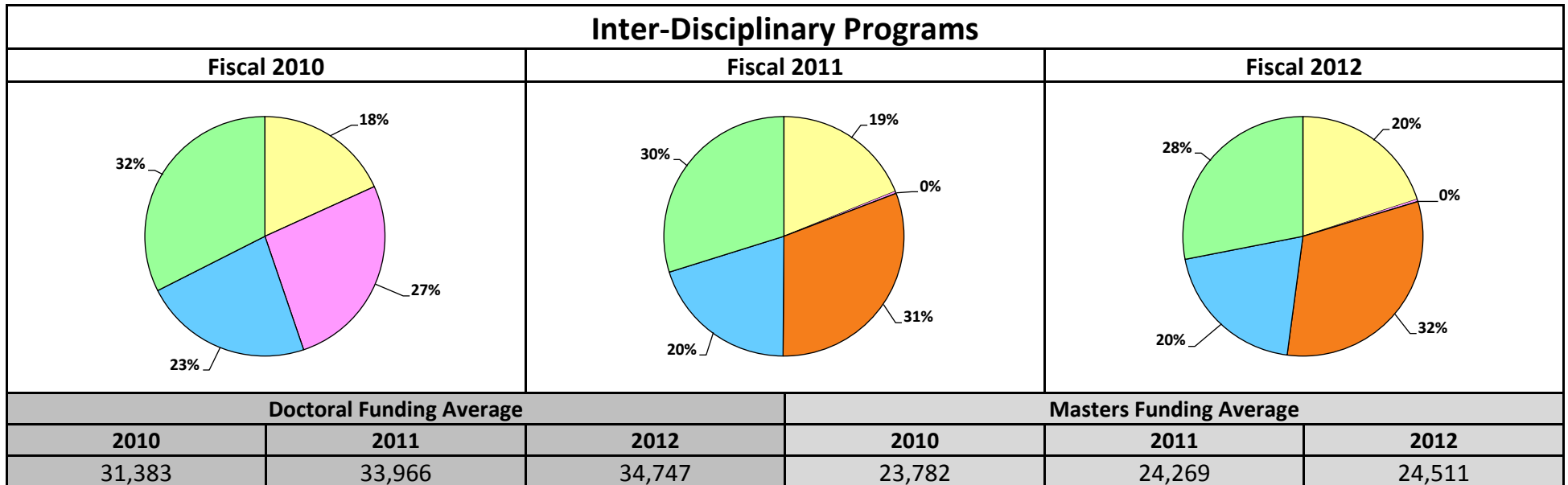
